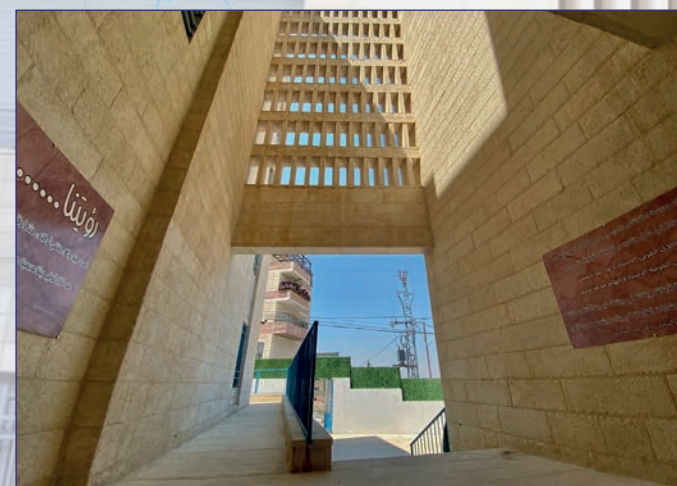

A letter from the Chair of Trustees

The Covid pandemic has changed many lives around the world with many of us, including our family, losing loved ones, close friends, past trustees and charity supporters. I am sure many of you reading this newsletter will also have been touched with sadness. After much consultation with the "Friends" UK, the Jerusalem local board and the Palestinian Authorities have now established an educational partnership with Atlantis Academy. This is now operational within the building for 75 children. The teaching of new skills will increase self-confidence and development through the devised curriculum.

The newly complete two floors of the building have been adapted and fully equipped to accommodate educational classrooms, a crèche and outdoor play areas (as you will see in the included photographs).



The Friends are continuing to raise funds for the continuation of construction work to the remainder of the building which will incorporate a clinic and Senior Citizen Day Care Centre at a later day due to the pandemic restrictions.

The Friends wish to express their profound gratitude to our Jerusalem Trustee, Ibrahim Younan and the local board for their enthusiasm, drive and persistence in bringing this project to fruition during what can only be described as a very turbulent time with many Covid restrictions hindering their progress.

Although the challenges have been immense, the Friends and local board have been greatly blessed by the Lord and we give thanks for your continued prayers and financial support. Without this, we could not achieve this momentous mile stone.
